IDEAS:

- Harrison Elementary:
 - May have a panel or two dedicated to building history (may apply to Harrison High School as well) and then a series of boards dedicated to just the time the building was an Elementary school
- Central Elementary:
 - May have a board dedicated if Hooven, E-Town, Miamitown, and Whitewater
 - Additional digital content may be available for Miamitown and Whitewater
- Crosby:
 - Not at meeting
- Junior School:
 - If additional sports memorabilia and/or student artwork is available gallery space could be created in the hallway leading to the gymnasium
- High School:
 - If newspapers do not scan well the news articles could be recreated digitally
 - Discussed having 4 panels 1 for each of the High School buildings
- All:
 - \circ $\;$ Desire to capture the existing buildings in some way
 - Video and/or using SHP's matterport camera was discussed
 - Discussed including QR codes on the boards for additional content
 - QR code could be an "add on" item so that it could be removed or updated as technology changes
