

Whitewater Valley Elementary: 3rd grade, Diane Barrow's class — "bat wings"

These are pictures of some of the bat wings the third grade students designed for a STEAM challenge called "Wings Wanted." For this STEAM lesson, the children switched classes. In one class they read a folktale called "Out of the Light, Into the Night" about how bats came to be and analyzed the story elements. In another class the children made up their own math story problems related to bats. In the third class, they created their wing designs after planning the day before. The bats were later tested to see how far they could fly.
