Important Registration Dates

- ▶ 9th, 10th, 11th grade meetings
 - January 28th
- ▶ Teacher Recommendation Day (Get signatures)
 - January 31st & February 1st
- ▶ Registration during English class
 - February 2nd & 3rd



Graduation Requirements– Class of 2023, 2024 & 2025

- ▶ 4 credits of English (English 9,10,11&12)
- ▶ 4 credits of Math (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra 2)
- ▶ 3 credits of Social Studies (American History, Government, and World History)
- ▶ 3 credits of Science (Biology, Physical Science and an elective Science)
- ▶ 1 credit of Fine Arts (not required for students who complete their Career Center program)
- ▶ .5 credit of Health

Graduation Requirements– Class of 2023, 2024 & 2025 (continued)

- ▶ .5 credits of Physical Education
 - May be exempted by 2 seasons of High School Interscholastic Sports, Marching Band, Cheerleading or JROTC
- ▶ 5 Elective credits (ACT/SAT prep is **HIGHLY** recommended for all College Prep and Advanced students)
- ▶ Financial Literacy Requirement
 - May be met through HSB 3 or Economics section of American Government (AP Government does **NOT** include Economics section, students must take HSB 3, Personal Finance, or Summer School Financial Literacy)

STEP 2: Earn a passing score on Ohio's high school Algebra 1 and English 2 tests. If students do NOT receive passing scores on either of the test, they may choose an option below to show equivalency

Ohio Honors Diploma Requirements

(You must fulfill all but one of the requirements to qualify)

- ▶ 4 credits English
- ▶ 4 credits Math
- ▶ 4 credits Social Studies
- ▶ 4 credits Science
- ▶ 1 credit Fine or Practical Art
- ▶ .5 credit Physical Education
- ▶ .5 credit Health
- ▶ .5 Financial Literacy
- ▶ 3 credits Foreign Language (or 2 years each of 2 separate languages)
- ▶ GPA of 3.5 (UNWEIGHTED)
- ▶ ACT score of 27 or SAT score of 1280



Honors Diploma Options

The State of Ohio has developed new alternative Honors Diploma Options. In addition to the traditional Academic Diploma with Honors, students have the option of obtaining the following new options:

- **Career Tech Honors Diploma**
- **STEM Honors Diploma**
- **Arts Honors Diploma**
- **Social Science and Civic Engagement Honors Diploma**

Course Change Policy

- ▶ NO changes in course selection will be made after the last day of school!!!!!! (this includes adding/dropping study halls)
- ▶ All students will be given their schedule before school is released and they must return it with a parent signature.
- ▶ After June 1, 2022, NO changes can be made to either semester.

College Credit Plus

- ▶ Any student who is wanting to be eligible for college credit must complete the following:
 - Students must sign a letter of intent by April 1st
 - Students must apply and be accepted for student status at the individual college by that college's deadline
 - Students must register for the individual classes by the college's deadline.

- **American Sign Language 1** (full year)
- **Manufacturing** (1st class full year, semester electives following)
 - Manufacturing has a new line up of classes and offerings
- **Entrepreneurship** (full year)
- **Science**
 - Marine Science (semester)
- **Technology** (1st class full year, semester electives following)
 - Technology has a complete overhaul with new opportunities to earn college credit if you attend the University of Cincinnati
- **Spanish**
 - Spanish 2 Adv (full year)
 - Occupational Spanish (semester)

Common Registration Questions



- ▶ How many classes do I need to sign up for?
 - A FULL schedule (7 bells)

- ▶ Do I need a foreign language to graduate?
 - No, but colleges recommend or require 2 years of the SAME language.

- ▶ What if I applied to go to Diamond Oaks next year?
 - You still need to register normally for a full schedule! Then we will remove your requests once you have officially been accepted.

Common Registration Questions

- ▶ Do I have to take the AP test if I have an AP class?
 - Yes. You will be charged for the test through your school fees at the beginning of the year.
- ▶ Can I schedule a Study Hall?
 - No (Study Hall may be scheduled for you as needed, after you receive your schedule, you can contact your counselor before June 1st to add a study hall)
- ▶ Can I retake a class that I have already passed?
 - At this time, the only classes that are available for duplicate credit are Band, Choir, Contemporary World Issues, and Technology Asst., TV Production & Broadcast.



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
