Why Harrison High School?



- Students receive materials for Registration during school– 1/30/2024
- Students fill out Registration forms with their parents & teachers by 2/5/2024
- Each student needs to register for 7 bells!
 - 1 English (1)
 - 1 Math (1)
 - 1 Social Studies (1)
 - 1 Science (1)
 - Health (.5)
 - PE (.25) must have parent sports exemption form signed to opt-out
 - 2 Electives

- Additional classes to consider
 - PE (traditional, summer, no credit sport exemption)
 - Fill out parent permission exemption form
 - Play 2 sports, marching band, cheerleading or JROTC
 - Turn in coach-signed verification forms after each season
 - Band
 - Art
 - Choir
 - Foreign Language (need to be enrolled in English 9CP or English 9Adv to take Spanish 1)
 - Other electives offered- if your program requires an application, it must be turned in with your registration sheet.



- Students have current teachers sign what classes they are recommended to take 1/30/24-2/2/24
- Please remember that NCAA Eligibility Center courses must be college prep classes or honors to meet eligibility standards.
- Students meet with a counselor one-on-one to go over their class choices. (2/5 and 2/6)

Ohio Honors Diploma Requirements

(You must <u>fulfill all but one of the</u> requirements to qualify)

- 4 credits English
- 4 credits Math
- 4 credits Social Studies
- 4 credits Science
- 1 credit Fine or Practical Art
- .5 credit Physical Education
- ▶ .5 credit Health
- Financial Literacy
- → 3 credits Foreign Language (or 2 years each of 2 separate languages)
- GPA of 3.5
 - ACT score of 27 or SAT score of 1280



New Honors Diploma Options

The State of Ohio has developed new alternative Honors Diploma Options. In addition to the traditional Academic Diploma with Honors, students have the option of obtaining the following new options:

- Career Tech Honors Diploma
- STEM Honors Diploma
- Arts Honors Diploma
- Social Science and Civic Engagement Honors Diploma

Southwest Resident Transfer Students

- Any southwest resident student who is planning on attending Wm Henry Harrison High School but is not currently enrolled in the district must enroll in the high school before they can register for classes.
- Registration is through the Central Office. Call at 728-4501 to set up an appointment. After you are enrolled, you can set up a time with your student's counselor to register for classes.
- You can register 2/5...the sooner the better!

Open Enrollment District

- Southwest Local Schools is an Open Enrollment District
- Open Enrollment applications must be submitted to the Superintendent of Schools between May 1 and May 31.
- Interviews with the Superintendent will take place in June
- Freshman Open Enrollment students do not lose a year of eligibility from interscholastic sports.
