We are looking forward to an exciting School Year in 2022-2023! Registration is an important step in preparing for student success in the year to come. We invite you to take time and look through our Registration Guide and consider courses that fit your unique interest and ability. In this process, please note that course requests will be honored to the best of our ability but cannot be guaranteed. Please read additional information as it pertains to your student below.

Advanced Placement:

Advanced courses offer more rigorous or challenging course work for students. The teacher, counselor and administration will use MAP scores and teacher feedback to place students appropriately. MAP testing is an assessment that shows student growth trends throughout the school year and current ability based on academic content standards. MAP testing is offered to all students throughout the year. If your child meets the required score, he/she will be recommended for Advanced Courses based on final teacher recommendation. A student could be placed in all or one Advanced Placement. Advanced Placement is not guaranteed from year to year. If your child did not meet requirements for Advanced Placement this year and you feel they belong in an Advance Course, a Petition to Upgrade form is available. There is a set criterium that needs to be met to be considered for these courses.

High School Credit Courses:

We are pleased to be able to offer students at Harrison Junior School the opportunity to take courses that will count for High School Credit. Please note that some High School Credit courses are based on MAP scores and a teacher recommendation while others are part of the 8th grade Harrison Junior school requirements. These courses will follow the student to High School and become part of their transcript and GPA. *Algebra 1, Geometry, Intro to Engineering, Advanced Art, Foreign Language 1&2* are High School credit classes.

*Please consider the information below when deciding about taking an advanced/ HS credit class:

1. High School courses will be included on your High School GPA and transcript
2. High School courses will be available 7th-12th grade. Therefore, you will have the opportunity to take this later.
3. If you fail a High school Course you may need to make up this credit in High School
4. We want all our students to be successful. If you are not ready for this level of commitment with an advanced or High School credit class, please wait. There will be other opportunities later with no penalty to you.
