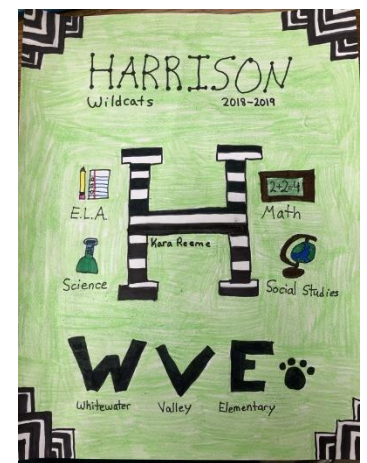
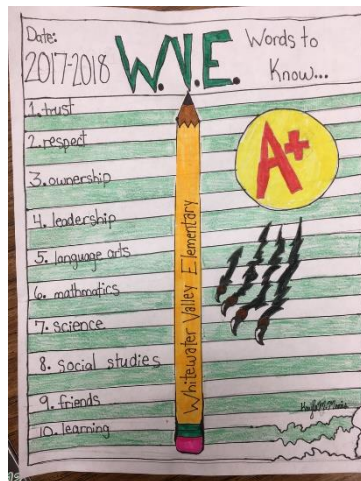
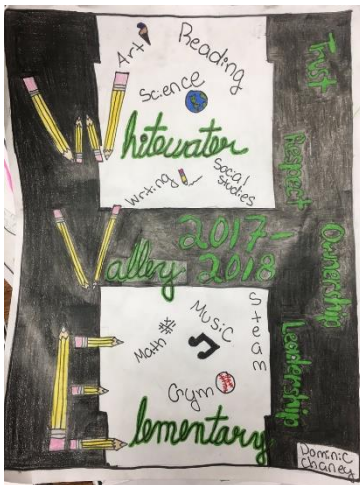
5th grade students are able to create and turn in a design cover for the WVE yearbook. Out of all entries, one will be chosen for the front cover, one will be chosen for the back cover, and the other top 10 will be placed on the interior front and back pages. There are some requirements for designs turned in.



Requirements:

- Must use 8.5x11 inch paper (copy paper)
 - Avoid having important design elements near the edge of the paper. Approximately ¼ inch could be cut out of the final cover once copied.
 - Your first and last name should be clearly written somewhere in the design
 - You must have Whitewater Valley Elementary written as part of the design
 - You must have the years 2019-2020 written as part of the design
 - **You draw YOUR OWN design idea. NO TRACING or COPYING of designs. This should be your own design idea; not a copy of a previous design.** It is okay to draw from images that we recognize as “WVE” symbols: the Wildcat, a claw, claw marks, etc... **BUT they must be drawn free hand, NOT TRACED.** Please be honest about your work!
 - Not required, but I suggest that you add color with marker or press with a medium to heavy pressure with crayon or color pencil. If you color lightly, it will look faded when copied...so it might not be chosen.
 - Free of mistakes, eraser marks, and scratchy color. Work neatly!!
- *Students may turn in more than one design! 😊*
