## Athletic/Academic After School Bus Shuttle

### **NORTH Athletic/Academic SHUTTLE (HS/JS STUDENTS)**

The Southwest Local School District strongly supports extracurricular activities and the high school after school study program for students. In an effort to assist parents with transportation from after school practices/activities and after school study programs, we are happy to provide a north and south shuttle service daily departing the Junior School at 5:00 PM daily. High School and Junior School students who participate in extracurricular activities or the high school study program and have a shuttle pass from their coach or teacher are eligible to ride the shuttle bus. The shuttle has set stops in certain areas of the community. The shuttle is not designed to be a door-to-door service but designed to get students delivered to particular areas and/or subdivisions closer to their homes. Parents will need to make arrangements to pick up their child at the shuttle stop or permit students to walk home from the stop (if they feel it is a safe walk). Times vary greatly depending on the number of students who ride on any given day.

5:00 PM      The North Activity Shuttle departs from the front of Harrison Junior School at 5:00 PM on school days. This Shuttle covers the area NORTH of Harrison Avenue, plus the walk zone for Harrison Elementary School which includes downtown Harrison and “The Meadows” between Harrison Elementary and Campbell Rd).
