



The holiday season is upon us. Hamilton County Commissioner Denise Driehaus and Health Commissioner Greg Kesterman shared several safe ways to observe Thanksgiving this year:

Low Risk Activities

- Host a holiday video chat
- Only celebrate with the people in your household
- Congregate outside in a garage or under a covered tent (while still maintaining distance, wearing a mask, washing your hands often)



Medium Risk Activities

- Dropping off meals to friends/family
- “Friendsgiving” with the people in your bubble who you are regularly exposed to
- Mirror restaurants with indoor gathering (keep windows open, wear masks unless eating/drinking, distanced seating, using disposable utensils)



High Risk Activities

- Inviting someone who doesn't believe in COVID-19 or hasn't been following guidance
- Poorly planned gatherings – this is something you need to think about ahead of time
- Celebrating as usual
