* Includes carry overs from previous week. The # of Positive cases = isolate for 5 days then mask for 5; close contacts mask up for 10 days or quarantine. The Hamilton County Department of Health quarantines students per ORC 3707.11. SLSD assists with contact tracing on a case-by-case basis. "Test & Stay" and "Test & Play" are both in place currently. As we have said since last year – the positive case numbers in our schools will reflect what is in the community. Paper 3-ply surgical masks are far more effective than most cloth masks / gators. We have these available in each of the schools.

*New STAFF positive cases for Jan. 17 – 23: 13 (1 HS, 2 JS, 5 MWE, 3 CR, 2 HE)

*New STUDENT positive cases for Jan. 17 - 23: 99 (26 HS, 30 JS, 11 MWE, 15 HE, 12 CR)

Important: When we see significant numbers of students and / or staff out due to COVID, we will shift to either universal masking, calamity or remote instruction. We will do this by grade, then building to start. It is important that families are prepared for either scenario. We monitor our numbers by the minute, each day.
